- Remove all perishables from your refrigerator and turn down the refrigerator temperature.**
- If applicable, turn down the thermostat in your room to 60F.**
- Remove all trash from your room and dispose it properly in the trash room or designated dumpster. Don't forget to recycle!**

- Approved pets are to be taken home as Residential Educational staff will not be responsible for the care of any pets.**
- Turn off all lights and lock the door to your room.**
